

Program Information

- Programs are designed for each particular scout level. In order to meet requirements effectively, we discourage siblings attending these programs. Only pre-registered scouts will be allowed in the program.
- Programs begin promptly at the stated time.
- If Liberty schools are canceled because of the weather then MLTNS is closed that day.



What to Bring / How to Dress Scouts

- Rain or shine, outdoor exploration is a part of each program.
- Scouts should dress for the conditions.
- In winter, scouts should dress appropriately for extended periods outdoors. In warmer weather, we recommend light-colored, long-sleeved shirts and pants as protection against plants and insects.
- Only tennis shoes or boots are allowed.



Please Note:

Our programs will assist your scouts in completing the requirements for each badge, elective and achievement. MLTNS does not award badges to scouts. Adults need to contact the Scout Leader in their pack or troop after the program to receive the earned badge.

Private Scout Programs

Schedule your den or troop to work on any of the available badges at a more convenient time for you. We can accommodate up to 25 scouts and 5 adults total at a time. Minimum program fee is \$65.

Badges, electives, and achievements may be arranged with the Naturalist. Please call (816) 781-8598 and ask for a Naturalist to schedule your program.

Private scout programs may be scheduled on Saturdays and after school as scheduling allows.



Eagle Scout, Gold Award, & Community Service Projects

A limited number of community service projects may be done by middle and high school scouts with adult supervision. Projects may include removal of invasive plants, trail maintenance, and bridge building and repair. Projects have to be planned with and agreed upon by a MLTNS staff person.
